CALL FOR VERBAL OR WRITTEN STAKEHOLDER SUBMISSIONS ON THE EXPROPRIATION BILL [B23-B2020]

The Legislature's Portfolio Committee on Infrastructure Development & Property Management is currently considering the Expropriation Bill [B23-B2020]. In accordance with its constitutional mandate to facilitate public participation in its legislative processes, the Committee will host a series of public hearings to solicit public inputs on the Bill.

The objectives of the Bill include:

- Providing for the expropriation of property to benefit the greater public,
- Regulating how properties can be expropriated to benefit the public, and,
- Providing for instances where no compensation is justified may be just and reasonable for the expropriation of property in the interest of the public.
