BRIEFING ON PLANS TO ENSURE SAFE AND SECURE ELECTIONS

Gauteng Police Commissioner Lieutenant-General Tommy Mthombeni will on Thursday, 9 May 2024, brief Members of the Gauteng Provincial Legislature's Portfolio Committee on Community Safety on the Province's plans to ensure safe and secure Elections as South Africans head to the polls on the 29th May 2024.
